**Refunds:**

On or before our closing date: All class, stabling, and all miscellaneous fees refunded. Less cancellation fee.

After closing date: No refunds given.

**Scheduling:**

**Entries will not be accepted without full payment and proper signatures.** *No phone/fax entries.* Entries postmarked by closing date may purchase scratches with no penalty. Ride times will be emailed to riders before the show and posted on Twin Rivers' Facebook page. Scheduling may require changing order of classes. Management reserves the right to cancel,

combine classes, limit each entry to 2 (two) rides per day or substitute judges. Scheduling for classes have the potential to be grouped my stable group or hauling group, with awards being mailed the day after competition. Awards to first, ribbons through third place.

### **About the Facility:**

Arenas and footing: Outdoors arenas with Premier Equestrian ProTex and All Purpose Footing mixed with beach sand from Florence and Silica Sand from Lane Mountain in Washington. The indoor Arena with Premier Equestrian Master's Blend Footing/Beach sand. All tests will be ridden in a 20m x 60m court.

#### Stabling:

All stabling for Saturday. Additional days by request.

6 permanent 12x12 matted box stalls in the upper event barn with full door.

20 portable 12x12 matted box stalls with full door and tent cover.

Stabling allocated in the order in which requests are received.

**Please strip stall upon departure unless you choose to pay an additional fee of \$20.00.**

#### Trailer/Exhibitor Parking:

Please obey all posted signs and personnel that will be helping exhibitors park. Please park in the same direction/location as other trailers. Please Park as close to the trailer next to you as reasonably safe. Exhibitors will be working from their trailers, so please leave reasonable space. Please leave driveway aisle clear through parking area to facilitate vehicle movements.

#### Dogs:

There are no dogs allowed on the show grounds except with prior permission of management.

Dogs are not permitted to be loose on competition grounds and must be held on a leash or otherwise restrained. Individuals must not lead dogs on a leash while mounted. Dog owners are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from their dogs' behaviors.

#### Sharps containers:

Competition management shall place a minimum of one sharps container per each competition for the disposal of needles and other disposable sharp instruments in convenient locations in barns housing competition horses. Competition management may fine any individuals including trainers, owners, exhibitors, or their agents up to \$100 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments. GR1210.4
