On FoxVillage deposit is already included in the stabling package. Stalls are being stripped by NAYC team members, and deposits will be directly donated to them.

Equine Vaccination Requirements

Competitions horses, more than 7 months of age, entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables.

All horses are required to provide proof of vaccinations no later than 5:00pm on the Wednesday before the show. If we do not received your vaccination records, you will not be allowed on the grounds, and we will not refund your entry or any associated fees.

Negative EIA/Coggins within 12mo is required for all out-of-state entries. Health Certificates are required for all out-of-state competitors.

Refunds:

A) 100% (except for the \$45 Cancellation Fee) before the show's closing date. B) After the closing date and upon presentation of a Veterinarian or Doctor's certificate, there will be a refund of 50% of the class fees After closing date: No refunds given.

Scheduling:

Silver Tail Spring League Show will be a one (1) ring show in the new outdoor court (pending weather conditions). Warmup will be in the indoor arena.

Entries will not be accepted without full payment and proper signatures. *No phone/fax entries.* Entries postmarked by closing date may purchase scratches with no penalty. Ride times will be emailed to riders before the show and posted on Silver Tail Farm's Facebook page. Scheduling may require changing order of classes. Management reserves the right to cancel, combine classes, limit each entry to 2 (two) rides per day or substitute judges. Scheduling for classes have the potential to be grouped by stable group or hauling group, with awards being mailed the day after competition.

Awards:

Ribbons 1st through 6th place for all levels. Ribbons, awards, and tests will be available after class has been pinned.

About the Facility:

Arenas and footing: Outdoors arenas with Premier Equestrian ProTex and All Purpose Footing mixed with beach sand from Florence and Silica Sand from Lane Mountain in Washington. The indoor Arena with Premier Equestrian Master's Blend Footing/Beach sand. All tests will be ridden in a 20m x 60m court.

Stabling:

All stabling per night. Additional days by request.

8 permanent 12x12 matted box stalls in the upper event barn with full door. 40 portable 12x12 matted box stalls with full door and tent cover. Stabling allocated in the order in which requests are received.

Please strip stall upon departure unless you choose to pay an additional fee of \$20.00. Or fee can be donated to the NAYC team members who will be stripping stalls.

Trailer/Exhibitor Parking:

Please obey all posted signs and personnel that will be helping exhibitors park. Please park in the same direction/location as other trailers. Please park as close to the trailer next to you as reasonably safe. Exhibitors will be working from their trailers, so please leave reasonable space. Please leave driveway aisle clear through parking area to facilitate vehicle movements.

Dogs:

There are NO DOGS allowed on the show grounds except with prior permission of management (liability insurance is voided due to dog incident occurrence). Dogs are not permitted to be loose on competition grounds and must be held on a leash or otherwise restrained. Individuals must not lead dogs on a leash while mounted. Dog owners are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from their dogs' behaviors.

Sharps containers:

Competition management shall place a minimum of one sharps container per each competition for the disposal of needles and other disposable sharp instruments in convenient locations in barns housing competition horses. Competition management may fine any individuals including trainers, owners, exhibitors, or their agents up to \$100 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments. GR1210.4

SHOW RULES

Online entries through Fox Village Entries – mail entries use form at end – ALL entries must include Silver Tail Farm waiver pages 7 – 9 this Prize list. [Fox Village - Online Entry](#)

All must wear an ASTM/SEI-approved equestrian safety helmet.

This is a schooling show, must use appropriate attire/foot wear.

The judge's decisions are final.

Grounds for disqualification and expulsion w/o a refund: unsportsmanlike conduct, use of severe bits or training devices, unruly or out-of-control horses, mistreatment of any horse as determined by show staff or judges, or exhibiting a horse that is exhausted, injured, or lame.

Any disputes or problems during the show should be brought to the attention of the show manager at the show office.

Park horse trailers in designated trailer parking area only.

Dogs allowed on the show grounds with permission of management.

We will follow USEF Dressage Rules as much as reasonable – in particular rules which are for safety or to maintain a level playing field will be followed

SPECIAL RULE: In order to allow for more people to ride, any horse may be ridden by a Youth Rider (under 18) or an AA at Intro or Training regardless of what other test/level it has been ridden by another rider. In other words, if you ride a third level test, your friend (spouse, sibling) may also ride it at Intro or Training provided if a Youth or AA rider.

WARNING, RELEASE, AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

I understand that horses are potentially dangerous animals, and can cause serious injury to me, including permanent injury and/or death, or damage to my property, including but not limited to my horse. I understand that any horse, regardless of its training and prior behavior, may act or react unpredictably at any time for any reason, and may bolt, spook, rear, buck, bite, kick, fall, strike out, stomp, trample, spin, fall on or collide with objects, collide with other horses, step on, over or become entangled in objects, tack, or equipment, or otherwise act in a manner that may cause injury and/or death to me, or damage to my property, including my horse. I understand that horse tack or other horse equipment can break, loosen, or otherwise fail, causing serious injury to me, including permanent injury and/or death, or damage to my property, including but not limited to my horse. I understand that any rider or handler of a horse may lose control of such horse at any time and for any reason, and that doing so may cause serious injury to me and my minor child, including permanent injury and/or death, or damage to my property, including my horse. I further understand that I am solely responsible for using proper safety equipment at all times while near, grooming, handling, lunging, and riding horses, including but not limited to wearing an ASTM-certified riding helmet and riding boots. I understand that the risks set forth in this paragraph and other similar risks are inherent to participation in any "equine activity" as defined by ORS § 30.687(2).

I understand there are potential hazards at an equine facility, including but not limited to uneven, slippery or rocky footing, open water, rodent holes, molehills, irrigation equipment, farming equipment, drainage and irrigation ditches, hoses, livestock, electric fencing, and loud noises. I further understand and acknowledge that there may be animals, including but not limited to dogs, other horses, cows, insects, reptiles, deer, cougars, coyotes, and bears, present at or in close proximity to an equine facility that present a risk of serious harm, injury, illness, damage, disease, or death to me, my child, and my property, including my horse.

The equine facility at which Silver Tail Farm, LLC ("Silver Tail") operates its business, including but not limited to the barns, arenas, outbuildings, paddocks, pastures, driveway(s), etc. is referred to herein as "Stable." I understand that the Silver Tail and Stable are "equine activity sponsors" as defined by ORS § 30.687(3). I understand that horse boarding, horse training, horseback riding instruction, exhibition in horse shows, and all activities and services related thereto sponsored by Silver Tail or Stable and its owners, members, employees, agents, and representatives each constitute an "equine activity" as defined by ORS § 30.687(2). I understand that by directly engaging in any such equine activity, I am a "participant" in an equine activity as defined by ORS § 30.687(5).

I UNDERSTAND THAT BY MY PRESENCE AT OR USE OF STABLE, I HAVE INDICATED I ACCEPT OREGON'S EQUINE INHERENT RISK LAWS' LIMITS OF LIABILITY RESULTING FROM THE INHERENT RISKS OF EQUINE ACTIVITIES. I UNDERSTAND THAT STABLE IS NOT A SPECTATOR AREA, AND BY MY PRESENCE AT OR USE OF STABLE, I WILL BE REGARDED AS A PARTICIPANT IN AN EQUINE ACTIVITY AND LIMITED BY OREGON'S EQUINE INHERENT RISK LAWS.

I UNDERSTAND THAT AS A CONDITION OF MY PRESENCE AT OR USE OF STABLE, I VOLUNTARILY, KNOWINGLY, AND EXPRESSLY ASSUME ANY AND ALL RISK RESULTING THEREFROM, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO ALL INHERENT RISKS. I UNDERSTAND THAT AS A CONDITION OF MY PARTICIPATION IN ANY EQUINE ACTIVITY SPONSORED BY SILVER TAIL OR STABLE, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO HORSE BOARDING, RIDING, TRAINING, DRIVING, HANDLING, OR GROOMING, AND RIDING AS A PASSENGER UPON AN EQUINE, I VOLUNTARILY, KNOWINGLY, AND EXPRESSLY ASSUME ANY AND ALL RISK RESULTING THEREFROM, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO ALL INHERENT RISKS.

I AGREE THAT BY SIGNING THIS AGREEMENT OF RELEASE, I AM KNOWINGLY, VOLUNTARILY, AND EXPRESSLY WAIVING MY RIGHT, AND THAT OF MY REPRESENTATIVE, TO BRING OR MAINTAIN ANY ACTION AGAINST OR RECOVER FROM SILVER TAIL, STABLE, LAURA PARK, EMILY PARK, CHRISTOPHER CRAIGHEAD AND ITS/HER/HIS/THEIR RESPECTIVE OWNERS, SHAREHOLDERS, MEMBERS, DIRECTORS, OFFICERS, EMPLOYEES, AGENTS, AND REPRESENTATIVES, OR ANY OF THEM, FOR ANY INJURY TO ME OR MY DEATH, OR DAMAGE TO MY PROPERTY, INCLUDING MY HORSE, RESULTING FROM OR ARISING OUT OF MY PARTICIPATION, OR THE PARTICIPATION OF MY MINOR CHILD, IN ANY EQUINE ACTIVITY SPONSORED BY SILVER TAIL OR STABLE, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO HORSE BOARDING, RIDING, TRAINING, DRIVING, HANDLING, OR GROOMING, AND RIDING AS A PASSENGER UPON AN EQUINE. HEREINAFTER, ALL OF THE RELEASED PARTIES NAMED IN THIS PARAGRAPH ARE COLLECTIVELY REFERED TO AS THE "RELEASED PARTIES." THIS AGREEMENT OF RELEASE INCLUDES, BUT IS NOT LIMITED TO, CLAIMS BASED UPON NEGLIGENCE.

I AGREE THAT BY SIGNING THIS AGREEMENT OF RELEASE, I AM KNOWINGLY, VOLUNTARILY, AND EXPRESSLY WAIVING MY RIGHT, AND THAT OF MY REPRESENTATIVE, TO BRING OR MAINTAIN ANY ACTION AGAINST OR RECOVER FROM THE RELEASED PARTIES FOR ANY INJURY TO ME OR MY DEATH, ANY INJURY TO OR THE DEATH OF MY MINOR CHILD, OR DAMAGE TO MY PROPERTY, INCLUDING MY HORSE, RESULTING FROM OR ARISING OUT OF MY PRESENCE AT OR USE OF STABLE. THIS AGREEMENT OF RELEASE INCLUDES, BUT IS NOT LIMITED TO, CLAIMS BASED UPON NEGLIGENCE.

I UNDERSTAND THAT BY SIGNING THIS AGREEMENT OF RELEASE, MY MINOR CHILD AND I ARE GIVING UP CERTAIN LEGAL RIGHTS THAT I/WE MIGHT OTHERWISE HAVE IF I/WE DID NOT SIGN THIS AGREEMENT OF RELEASE, INCLUDING THE RIGHT TO RECOVER DAMAGES FROM THE RELEASED PARTIES FOR ANY INJURY TO ME OR MY MINOR CHILD, MY DEATH OR THE DEATH OF MY MINOR CHILD, OR DAMAGE TO MY PROPERTY, INCLUDING MY HORSE. I ACKNOWLEDGE THAT I HAVE BEEN ADVISED AND HAD AN OPPORTUNITY TO OBTAIN INDEPENDENT LEGAL ADVICE PRIOR TO SIGNING THIS AGREEMENT.

I agree that my execution of this agreement of release is binding upon me and/or my representative, and the Released Parties shall not be liable for my injury and/or death, my minor child's injury and/or death, or damage to my property, including my horse.

I agree to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless the Released Parties for any and all injuries that I or my child suffers, including death, and damage to my property, including my horse, caused by, resulting from, or arising out of my or my minor child's participation in any equine activity sponsored by Silver Tail or Stable, including but not limited to horse boarding, riding, training, driving, handling, or grooming, and riding as a passenger upon an equine, or my or my minor child's presence at or use of Stable. This promise of indemnity includes attorneys' fees and costs incurred by the Released Parties in defending against any claims by me, or my personal representative, guardian, or heirs.

I intend this Agreement to be as broad and inclusive as permitted under Oregon law. I FURTHER INTEND MY SIGNATURE TO BE A COMPLETE AND UNCONDITIONAL RELEASE OF ALL LIABILITY TO THE EXTENT PERMITTED UNDER OREGON LAW. I agree that if any provision of this Agreement is deemed to be unenforceable by a court of appropriate jurisdiction, then the remaining provisions of this Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.

I HAVE READ AND UNDERSTAND THIS AGREEMENT, AND KNOWINGLY, VOLUNTARILY AND EXPRESSLY CONSENT TO ITS TERMS. I ACKNOWLEDGE THAT I HAVE RECEIVED A COPY OF THIS AGREEMENT.
